SELECTION CRITERIA FOR FALL TERM:

Kent State University's freshman admission policy differentiates among students with varying degrees of preparation for college studies. The students most likely to be admitted and succeed at the Kent Campus are those who have graduated with at least 16 units of the recommended college preparatory curriculum in high

school, who have achieved a high school grade point average of 2.5 or higher (on a 4.0 scale), and whose composite ACT score is 21 or better (combined critical reading and math SAT of 980).
