SELECTION CRITERIA FOR FALL TERM:

Direct Admission: Students are admitted conditionally if they have not submitted ACT or SAT entrance exam scores when applying to The University of Toledo and/or if they have not completed the required college preparatory curriculum, as outlined in the University application for undergraduate admission.

Students admitted conditionally are required to take a comprehensive set of placement exams prior to the start of the term for which they have been admitted. Results of those exams may require that students receive intensive instruction, tutoring, specialized advising, and access to other support services designed to prepare them for academic success.

Additionally, students may be required to take developmental coursework prior to taking specific college level classes.
